1. Suriname - Capacity building in financing

A module for strengthening capacities and competencies of the officials of the institutions linked to the water sector at the sanitation level that allows them to build a mechanism for planning and prioritizing projects in this strategic sector has been implemented.

2. Webinar focused on wastewater reuse experiences in Latin America (2022)

A webinar focused on wastewater reuse experiences in Latin America was held on September 15th, 2022, with the virtual participation of 22 experts.

3. Training on the requirements and criteria of international financing agencies (WB/IDB)

Training on the requirements and criteria of international financing agencies (WB/BID) for providing financing for water and sanitation projects (June 15th, 2023). 34 participants attended.

4. Red SNIP - Identification of mechanisms and options to facilitate the financing of investments in sanitation infrastructure and to provide sustainability to the operations of water and sanitation operators through tariffs

At the regional level, 9 sessions with simultaneous interpretation (Spanish-English) were held from August 23rd to October 13th, 2022, with an average participation of 14 people per session, in which project counterparts and representatives of the SNIPs (Dominican Republic, Mexico, Colombia, Honduras, Costa Rica, Trinidad and Tobago, Guyana, Jamaica, and Belize) participated. The sessions were focused on identify mechanisms and options to facilitate the financing of investments in sanitation infrastructure and to provide sustainability to the operations of water and sanitation operators through tariffs. In the area of public investments, CReW+ is collaborating with the National Public Investment Systems Network (Red SNIP) to strengthen this support network specifically on water and sanitation issues.

5. Peer-to-peer exchange session between the Dominican Republic and Honduras on the fundamentals of water and sanitation project formulation and linkage to funding sources
