Honduras started the technical work for the design of a pipeline system and wastewater plant in the Omoa Bay.

Panama is in the process of developing the Technical Norm of Marine Water Quality and it is programming a series of workshops to disseminate the Good Practice Guidelines amongst the Isberyala Indigenous Community in the Guna Yala indigenous territory.

A rehabilitation project of three pumping stations in the sewerage system is being developed in the City of Rodas, Cuba. The sewerage system will reach 75% of the coverage of the population, which was intended in the original design more than 30 years ago.
